ACTIVE SHOOTER

In the event of an active shooter:

> If it is Safe to do so: <u>RUN</u>, Evacuate the Area

- Leave Belongings
- Warn Others
- Keep Your Hands Visible
- Follow Instructions from Emergency Responders
- Call 911/Public Safety when Safe to Do So

> If it is Unsafe to Evacuate: <u>HIDE</u>

- O Secure the Room You Are In
- Lock Doors If you can
- O Barricade the Door with whatever you can
- O If you are in a Hall get into a Room
- O Be Out of Sight, Be Quiet, Remain Calm
- O Hide Behind Large Heavy Objects That May Offer Protection
- O Call 911/Public Safety when Safe to Do So
- o Follow Instructions from Emergency Responders
- O Do Not Unsecure the Area until Instructed to do so by Law Enforcement

> As a Last Resort: FIGHT

- As a <u>last resort</u> and only when your life is in <u>imminent danger</u>, attempt to disrupt and/or incapacitate the shooter
- o Act Quickly and Aggressively
- o Throw Objects or Improvise Weapons
- Be Loud and Assertive
- Commit to Your Actions
- o A Temporary Disruption may Provide a Chance to Run
