
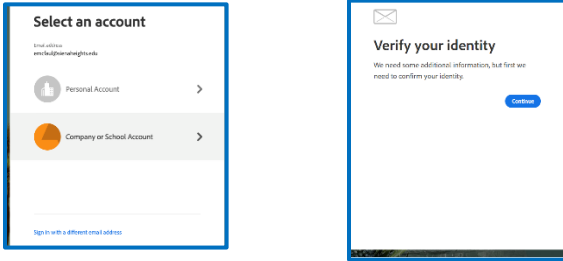
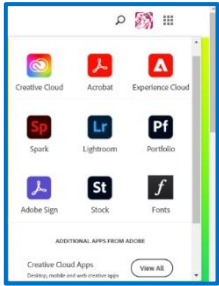


# Adobe ID Account –Computer or School Account Setup

## Download Applications on the Windows Computers

<p>Log on to <a href="https://www.adobe.com/">https://www.adobe.com/</a> using <b>Google Chrome</b>, the <b>sign-in link</b> is located on the right top corner of the web page.</p>	
<p>You need to log on to a <b>“Computer or School Account”</b>, and then <b>Adobe</b> will authorize your account after you <b>log in</b> using your Siena <a href="mailto:yourname@sienaheights.edu">yourname@sienaheights.edu</a>, followed by your password for your MySiena account. Next, you will receive an <b>e-mail from Adobe</b> with a code to log on to your account.</p>	
<p>After you have logged on to your <b>Adobe ID Personal account</b>, <b>tap on the black squares</b>, found on the top right section of the menu, to get to the drop-down menu, next, click on the <b>View All button</b>, for the <b>Creative Cloud Apps</b>. Pending on your license; the <b>download button</b> appears when which app, or apps you have <b>permission to download</b>.</p>	
<p>Next, the next menu will display with the <b>Creative Cloud app</b>, download that app first, keep the <b>CC menu window open</b>, and <b>download</b> the rest of the software you would like installed on your <b>office Windows computer</b>. Remove any previous Adobe applications, before downloading and installing Adobe Acrobat DC and Creative Cloud apps.</p>
