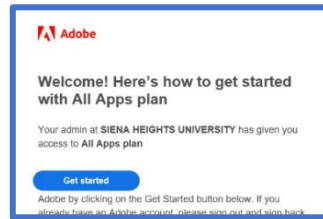


# Setting up you're Named License Adobe Creative Cloud Software For your Enterprise Name account license

## Signing on to the Adobe website

Open your e-mail from **Adobe** and tap on the **Get Started** button. If no e-mail goes to the **profile link below** to log in to your account.

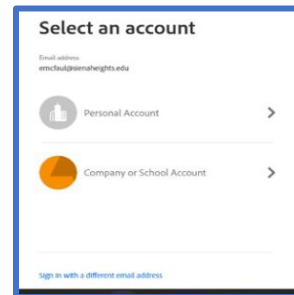

After you type your Adobe account information tap on the **Company or School Account Link**.

Type your [username@sienaheights.edu](mailto:username@sienaheights.edu), then tap on **School account**.

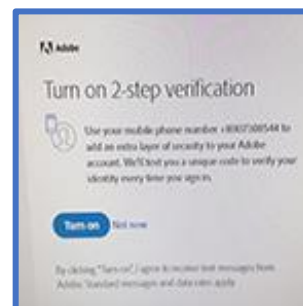
Using the **Enterprise account** now authenticates your **same password as your MySiena password**. Tap on the **Sign in button**.



You also have the choice to **sign in without a password**. Download the app features listed on the Adobe menu.



Next, the Adobe menu allows you to have a **2-step verification** for an access code through **your phone** or **e-mail**.

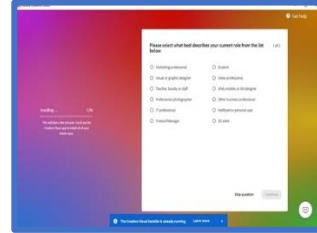


Once you have logged into your **Adobe Enterprise account**, on the right top of the screen, click on a **series of dots**, tap below **Creative Cloud Apps**, and then tap on the **View All** button.



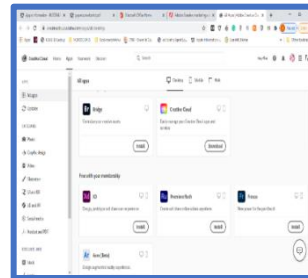
### Download the Creative Cloud App

Starting with downloading the **Creative Cloud application installation** will take ten minutes.



From the **Creative Cloud App** menu which will allow you to pick the **Creative Cloud applications** you would like to download on your (2) Name license computers.

From the **Creative Cloud App**, you will be able to **download** any updates on your (2) computers from this menu, by selecting on the top left corner of the screen, on the updates.



**Special Note:** The **Adobe Name License** grants you **(2) Name licenses** to download the software on **two different devices**, however, you are **not authorized** to use both **Adobe Name devices** at the same time.
