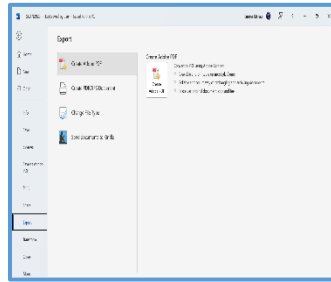
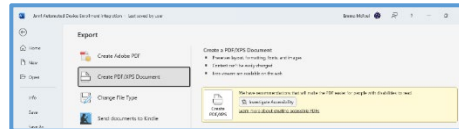


# Word Export Option

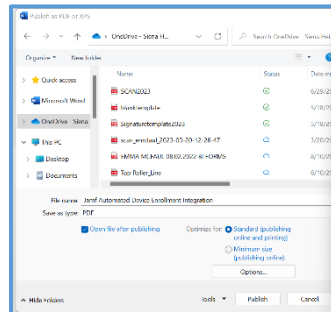
Open the Desktop Microsoft Word application. Open a **document** you would like to export as a **PDF/A** document. From the **File menu**, tap on **Export** to get to the dialog box.



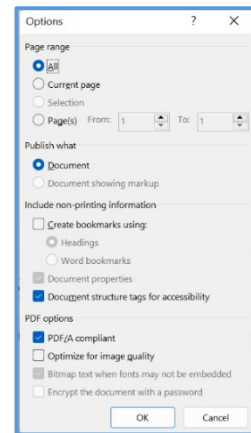
Create a **PDF/XPS** document. Tap on the Create PDF/XPS button to the right.



Tap on the **Options** dialog box and select the **(PDF/A)** check box.

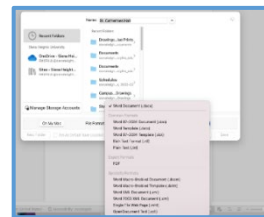


From the Options tab to confirm your settings. Finalized your document by tapping on the OK button, and if you have Adobe Acrobat as a program on your computer, your new PDF/A will open in the application.

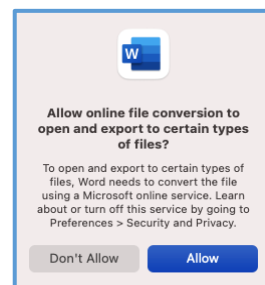


## Mac Office 365 Export Options

Open the **Microsoft Word application** from the application folder on your **Mac device**. Go to File and open from a **PDF document** you would like to edit from your **Microsoft OneDrive**, then tap on the **Open** button.



**File Open**, and the message allows online file conversion to open and export to certain types of files, appears to **tap on the allow button**.



When the conversion is taking place and completed, you can edit the document. You can add **text inside boxes** to add extra text to documents with drawings, images, or tables.
